

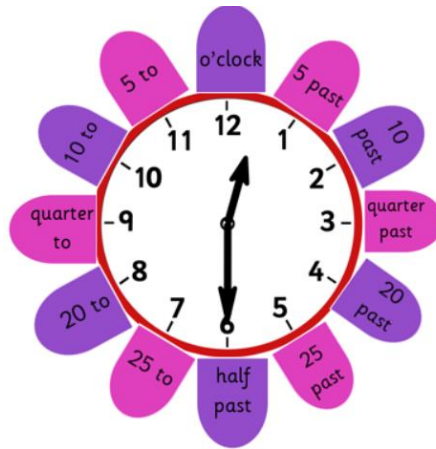


Year 2 Summer 2 KIRFS

Key Instant Recall Facts (KIRFs) are designed to support the development of the arithmetic skills that underpin all maths learning in school. KIRFs help reduce the cognitive load when learning maths and greatly support the development of mental maths agility.

Recall time facts:

5- and 15-minute intervals, O'clock and half past.



In addition, you can help by practising the following:

Recognise $\frac{1}{3}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of object shape or quantity	
Recap x5, x10 tables and their related division facts	e.g $2 \times 10 = 20$ $10 \times 2 = 20$ $20 \div 10 = 2$ $20 \div 2 = 10$
Number bonds to 100 (linked to number bonds to 10)	$10 + 90 = 100$ $20 + 80 = 100$ $30 + 70 = 100$ $40 + 60 = 100$ $50 + 50 = 100$
