Class One



Class 1 have been busy developing firm foundations in their number understanding this week. We have been consolidating finding ways in which to make 5 using double sided counters and had a go at recording the different ways that we found. We have had fun reading 'Supertato' and thinking about how we can keep ourselves healthy.

Class Two



In Class 2, the children have been using resources to show their understanding of number bonds and they have applied it to adding 3 or more numbers together. In literacy, we have been planning our own setting description with some impressive vocabulary. In RE, we have continued to think about Creation and the children have discussed how they show thanks to God.

Class Three



Class 3 have been investigating the effect of different liquids on our teeth. We have used orange juice, coca-cola and tea to understand tooth decay. We were fascinated with the results which proved that orange juice (although healthy!) can damage our teeth if we don't look after them.

Class Four



In our class book, Friend or Foe, we have reached a crucial decision point for the two evacuees. To investigate the for and against points the class role-played the different reasons using conscience alley, before reading on to find out what our characters had decided to do. We have been building our descriptive skills, looking at similes and personification and furthering our fraction knowledge, exploring fractions calculations.
